


### Public Expenditure as Percentage of GDP, 2000-2016











### Unemployment Rate



During the years 2010-2014 only **3,800** housing units were marketed by the government to the Arab population



Every year, 40% of the new subsidy for bus transportation will be allocated to the Arab authorities, until equality is achieved








Differential budgeting has begun gradually in elementary and junior-high schools, and is expected to be fully implemented by 2019

## Negev Bedouin - Background

- 240,000 Bedouin in the Negev area live in recognized and unrecognized villages
- The Bedouin fall behind in most socio-economic parameters compared to the rest of the population:


